How are we spending the Pupil Premium?

We draw on research evidence (such as the Sutton Trust toolkit) and evidence from our own experience to allocate funding to activities that are most likely to maximize achievement. We never confuse eligibility for the Pupil Premium with low attainment, and focus on supporting our disadvantaged pupils achieve the highest levels of progress
