Hegarty Maths Online HW	<p>Pupils should complete at least 4 topics per week.</p> <p>On the Hegarty website there is a 'donut' that displays how many topics have been completed. Your child should be filling up their donut.</p>
English	<p>Piece of extended writing (e.g. summary, creative writing, essay- varies from week to week). Minimum 1 side of A4 (may vary according to task set).</p>
Science	<p>A minimum of one page of A5 of self-quizzing each week on the correct knowledge organiser.</p>
History	<p>A minimum of one A5 of self-quizzing each week on the correct knowledge organiser. Or, a short written task set by the teacher.</p>
Religion	<p>A minimum of one A5 of self-quizzing each week on the correct knowledge organiser. Or, a short written task set by the teacher.</p>
French Online HW	<p>A minimum of one A5 side of self-quizzing each week on the correct knowledge organiser. Optional, but highly recommended: Nutty Tilez on thisislanguag.com.</p>

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
