English	Piece of extended writing (e.g. summary, creative writing, essay- varies from week to week). Minimum 1 side of A4 (may vary according to task set).
Science	Learn definitions set by their teacher, complete a minimum of one A4 page of My GCSE Science notes and answer one page of examination questions.
History	Extended writing and revision from the knowledge organiser which alternates every week, or other tasks set by the teacher.
Religion	Extended writing and revision from the knowledge organiser which alternates every week.
French** Online HW	Learning homework of up to 10 sentences, and tasks set on thislanguage.com .
