How are we spending the Pupil Premium?

We draw on research evidence (such as the Sutton Trust toolkit) and evidence from our own experience to allocate funding to activities that are most likely to maximize achievement. We evaluated spending in 2018/2019 and have decided to continue and increase the interventions that had the biggest impact on pupil progress. We never confuse eligibility for the Pupil Premium with low attainment, and focus on supporting our disadvantaged pupils achieve the highest levels of progress. We intensify support in year 7 so that pupils begin year 8 at a level in line with - or exceeding - national expectations, enabling them to access the curriculum.
